




Recognition of **Prior Learning**

More opportunities for students.

Currently, the South Australian Government is offering more opportunities for students.

This means eligible students can:

Access this course or more regardless of their prior

 School-enrolled students are entitled to access one Certificate Il and one Certificate III course while at school.




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Enrolment Process Step by Step with you



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
