




Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), formally recognises a person's existing skills and knowledge towards the achievement of a nationally recognised qualification or statement of attainment.

NEW AGE EDUCATION

More opportunities for students.

Currently, the South Australian Government is offering more opportunities for students.

This means eligible students can:

Access this course or more regardless of their prior

 regardless of their prior qualifications undertake more than one course or short course.

School-enrolled students are entitled to access one Certificate II and one Certificate III course while at school.

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Some creatives maybe eligible for *funding* opportunities *for* the following qualifications:

CUA51020Diploma of Screen and MediaSHB20216Certificate II in Salon AssistantSHB20121Certificate II in Retail CosmeticsSHB30121Certificate III in Beauty Services

A student may be eligible for a subsidised training place if they live or work in South Australia, and:

- Are an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or
- Are a permanent Australian resident, or

Hold a state sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residency (see Eligible visa types) https://providers.skills.sa.gov.au/ subsidised-training

and are:

16 years or over and not enrolled at school.

School-enrolled students are subject to separate eligibility criteria, see Training School Students.

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


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Enrolment Process Step by Step *with* you



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
