This qualification covers a range of well-developed innovative makeup and beauty skills.

Successful graduates will be responsible for their own productivities, obtaining capacities to work cooperatively with a range of industry associates including makeup artists, photographers, fashion stylists, beauty therapists and media production staff.

The beauty division involves beauty and makeup consultations, beauty and makeup client assessments and advice, application techniques for classic and high fashion eyelash extensions, eyebrow shaping and design, hair removal, contra-indications, contra-actions, preparation procedures when performing beauty and makeup treatments, sterilisation, disinfection, health and safety, cosmetic chemistry, after-care advice, the beauty professional, reception skills, promotional activities and the beauty business.

The makeup division houses techniques, designs and applications for the classic bride, day and evening, fashion editorials, photographic, catwalk, airbrush and creative makeup platforms. Additionally

covering detailed skills required when preparing the skin prior to makeup applications, the professional way to conceal, select and apply foundation colour principles and knowledge, the importance of understanding and working with colour levels and reflects, the art of contouring. Corrective skills and techniques for contouring, lip designs, eye, lash and eyebrow designs are a focus.

Creatives will have the skills and knowledge to work as part of a team or on a freelance basis. in settings such as makeup studios, retail cosmetic counters, beauty salons, spas, fashion and media sets, photography studios and show production work for fashion shows and events.







More opportunities for students.

Currently, the South Australian Government is offering more opportunities for students.

This means eligible students can:

- Access this course or more regardless of their prior **(+)** qualifications undertake more than one course or short course.
- School-enrolled students are entitled to access one Certificate Il and one Certificate III course while at school.

Some creatives maybe eligible for funding opportunities for the following qualifications:

CUA51020 Diploma of Screen and Media SHB20216 Certificate II in Salon Assistant SHB20121 Certificate II in Retail Cosmetics SHB30121 Certificate III in Beauty Services

A student may be eligible for a subsidised training place if they live or work in South Australia, and:

- Are an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or
- Are a permanent Australian resident, or
- Hold a state sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residency (see Eligible visa types) https://providers.skills.sa.gov.au/ subsidised-training

and are:

16 years or over and not enrolled at school.






